





KOSHER RENTAL PROCESS AND PROTOCOL


Chair-man Mills works in affiliation with  and can provide kosher-certified products for your kosher events. Please read through the process outlined below for our FAQs.

There are two types of Kosher Events:

Supervised Events:

- Must have a  certified Mashgiach on site for the duration of the event to monitor and supervise the use of the kosher product. They must wrap the kosher product up at the close of the event to ensure our product is returned to us kosher.
- The event must be registered with  in advance of delivery. Should the event not be registered accordingly, our internal Mashgiach will not be able to release the rentals for delivery at the cost of the client.
- A Kosher  Certified Caterer must be affiliated with the orders placed.
- Orders cannot be placed by third party General Public as we must ensure all Kosher processes are followed.

Unsupervised Events:

- Are events where Kosher food is served without the supervision of a Mashgiach.
- For these events, a release of Liability form must be filled out via . This allows us to release these items to you.
- Metal Items – Such as cutlery, and limited-service items can be used for unsupervised events as it can be made kosher through the kashering process.
- Platters and plates – we can only provide glass options for this.

MEAT VERSUS DAIRY


There are two categories of Kosher food: Meat and Dairy.

Please note that our product is designated to one of the two and cannot be used interchangeable.

KASHERING PROCESS

All metal items used in Kosher events come from our regular inventory and go through the process called “Kashering” which is where our internal mashgiach boils, dips, and blesses the items to certify them as kosher.

Fees associated with Kosher Orders

- Mashgiach fee
 - This is a fee added to all kosher orders and covers the cost of our internal mashgiach who will kasher, wrap and ensure all kosher orders follow the  process.
 - Mashgiach fee is a percentage based on the product requiring kashering.
- Product Cost
 - Due to the nature of kosher events and the additional day or two of turnover on product required based on the kashering of products, a slight surcharge is included on most of our kosher products.

Specify whether we wrap product in skids or wrap product in “threes” for delivery through narrow doors/hallways. This information is crucial as only a Mashgiach can unwrap the items and we cannot break down skids that have been wrapped by should they not fit when delivering.
